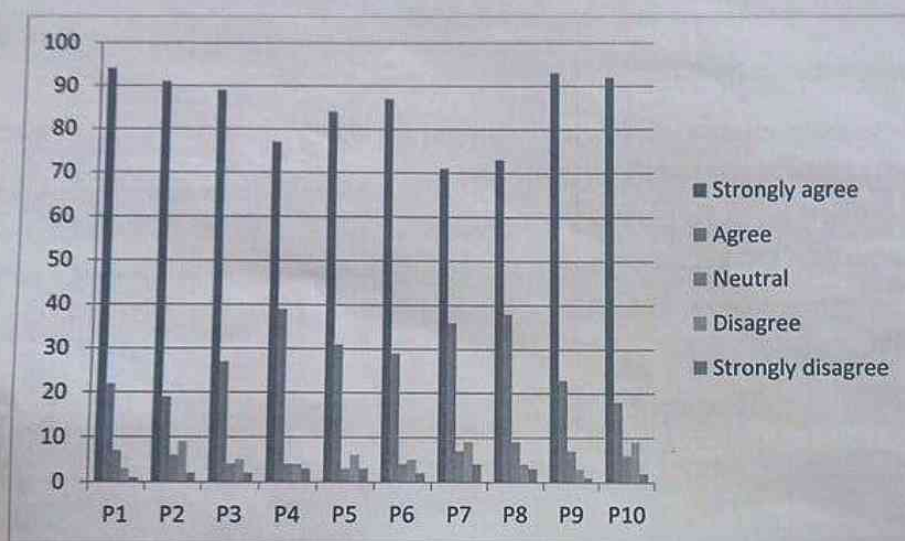
Major Parameters for Feedback Form

Analysis of Feedback:

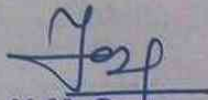

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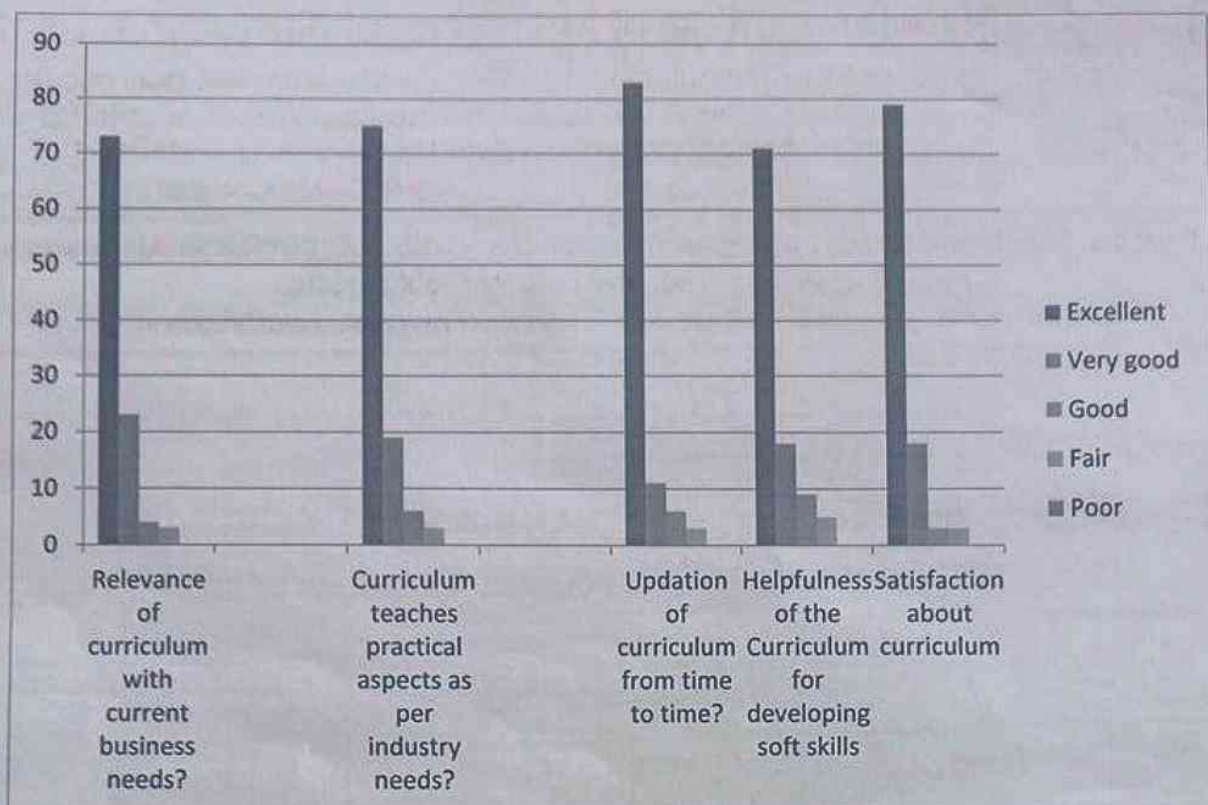
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ANALYSIS OF STUDENT'S FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

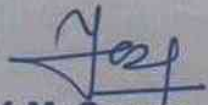

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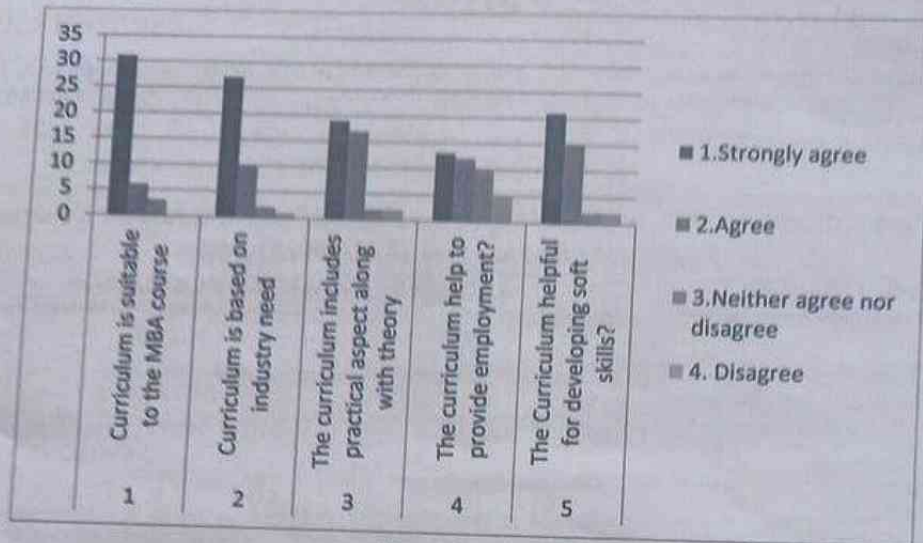

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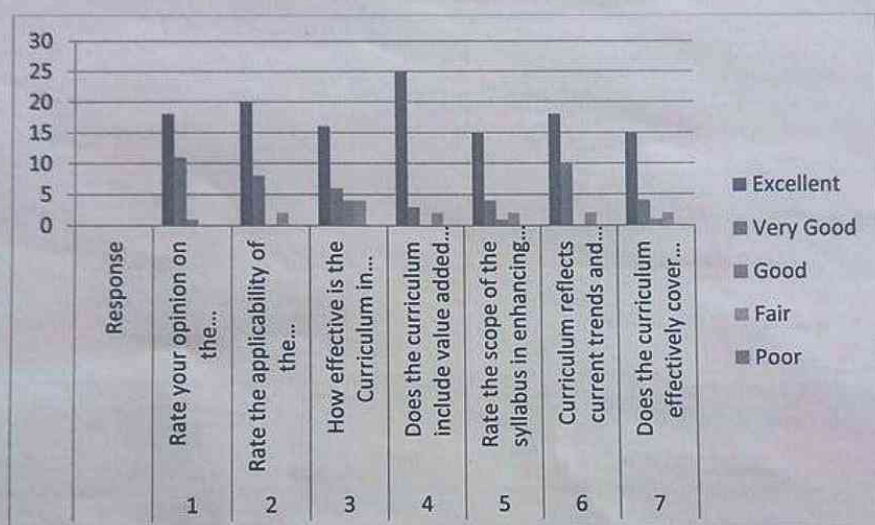
ANALYSIS OF EMPLOYERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

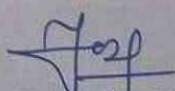
